## Karijini National Park

Karijini National Park is an iconic, unspoiled nature-based destination. Filled with unique and diverse landscapes, a visit here is an unforgettable outback experience.

Located 1,500km north of Perth and around 80km north-east of Tom Price, Karijini (formerly Hamersley Range) National Park is the second largest national park in Western Australia covering 627,422 hectares and has been ranked in the top 5 visitor experiences for the state.

Karijini is famous for its spectacular gorges and slot canyons, towering sheer sided chasms up to 100 metres deep, dramatic waterfalls, rocky creeks, refreshing waterholes and colours ranging from pindan red-orange to deep blue-purple rocks and jade green water.

This is an ancient part of the planet. Standing deep inside a gorge, you'll feel like you've taken a journey back in time, to the centre of the earth. Billions of years in the making, the slow process of erosion has carved the shape of the land out of rocks that are over 2.5 billion years old to form this intriguing landscape and complex ecology.





## Karijini Eco Retreat

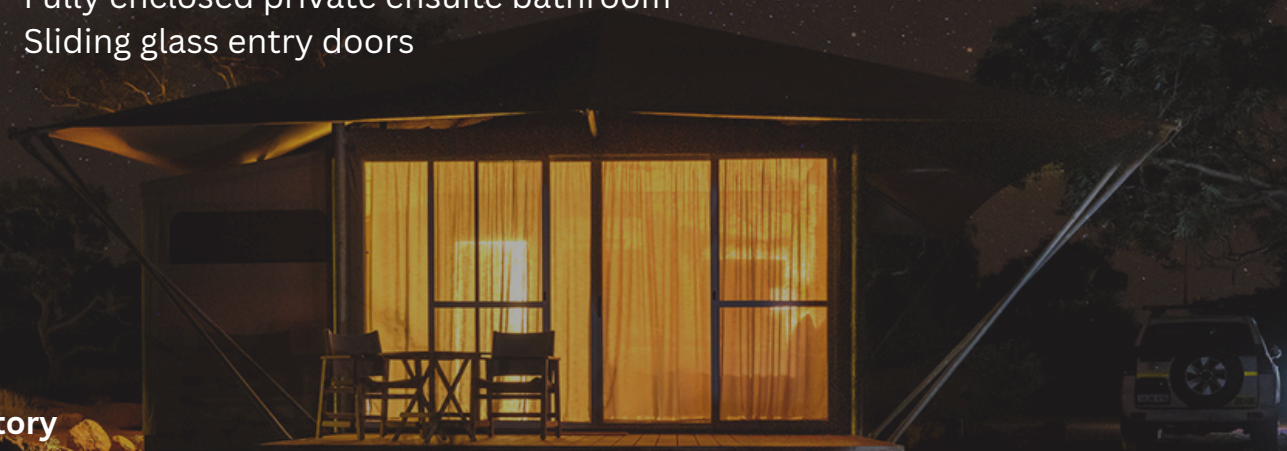

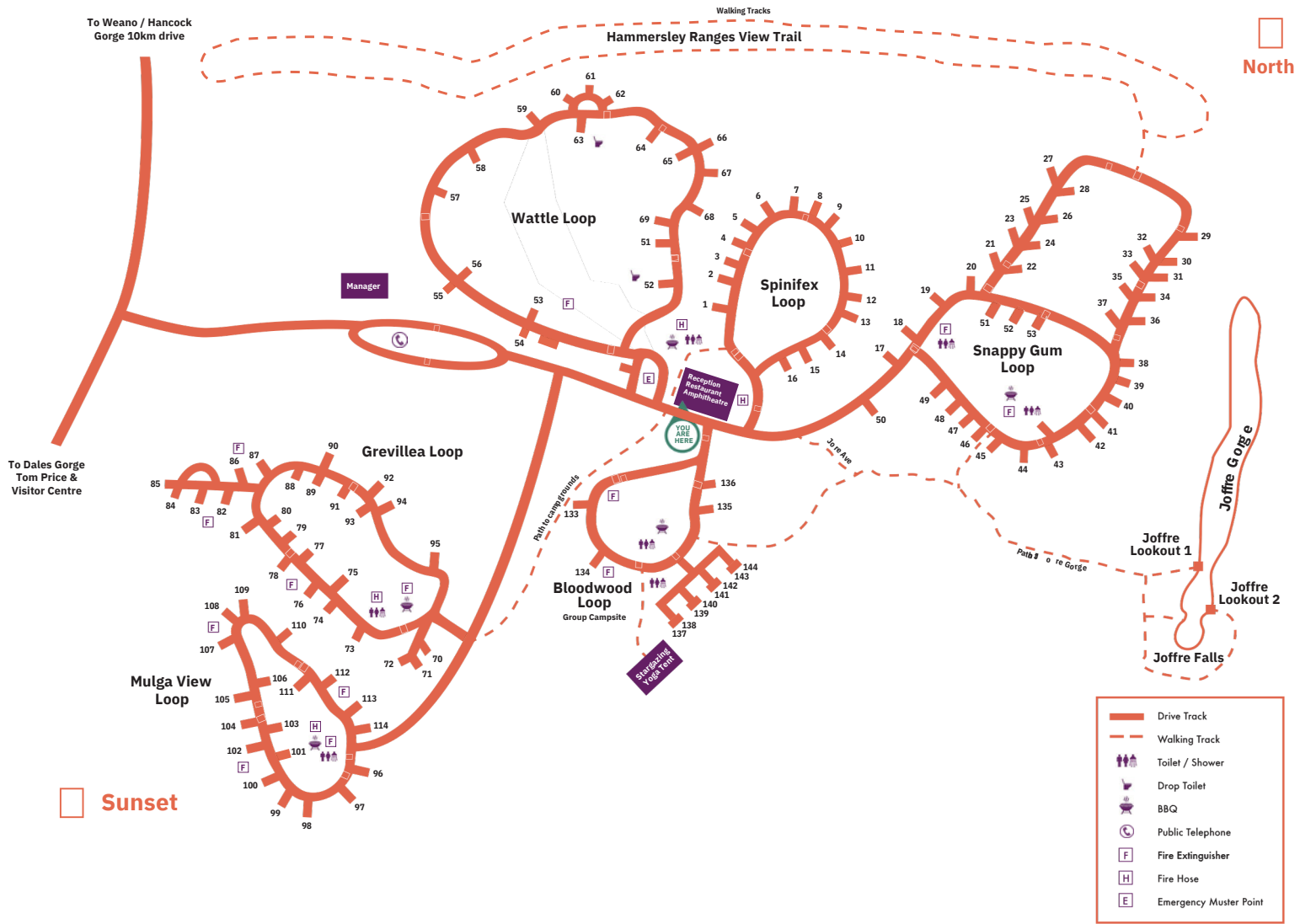

# Site Map

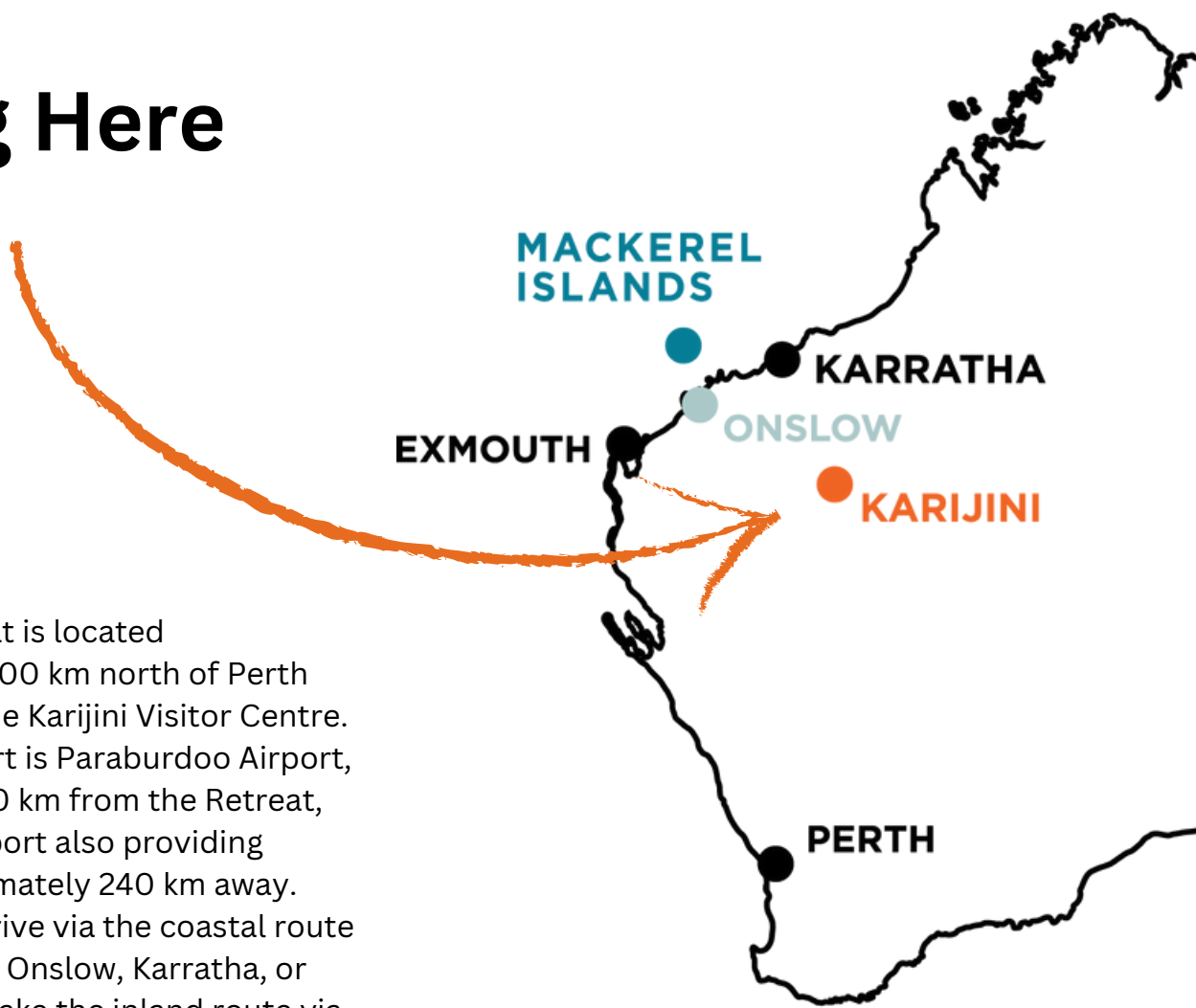






# Getting Here

## Go West



Karijini Eco Retreat is located approximately 1,500 km north of Perth and 35 km from the Karijini Visitor Centre. The nearest airport is Paraburdoo Airport, approximately 130 km from the Retreat, with Newman Airport also providing access at approximately 240 km away. Guests can self-drive via the coastal route through Exmouth, Onslow, Karratha, or Port Hedland, or take the inland route via Cue and Meekatharra.

For group transport, Go West, based in Tom Price, offers buses ranging from 12 to 55 seats. They provide transfers from the airport to the Retreat and from the Retreat to the Karijini Visitor Centre. Travel between these locations is now fully accessible via sealed bitumen roads.

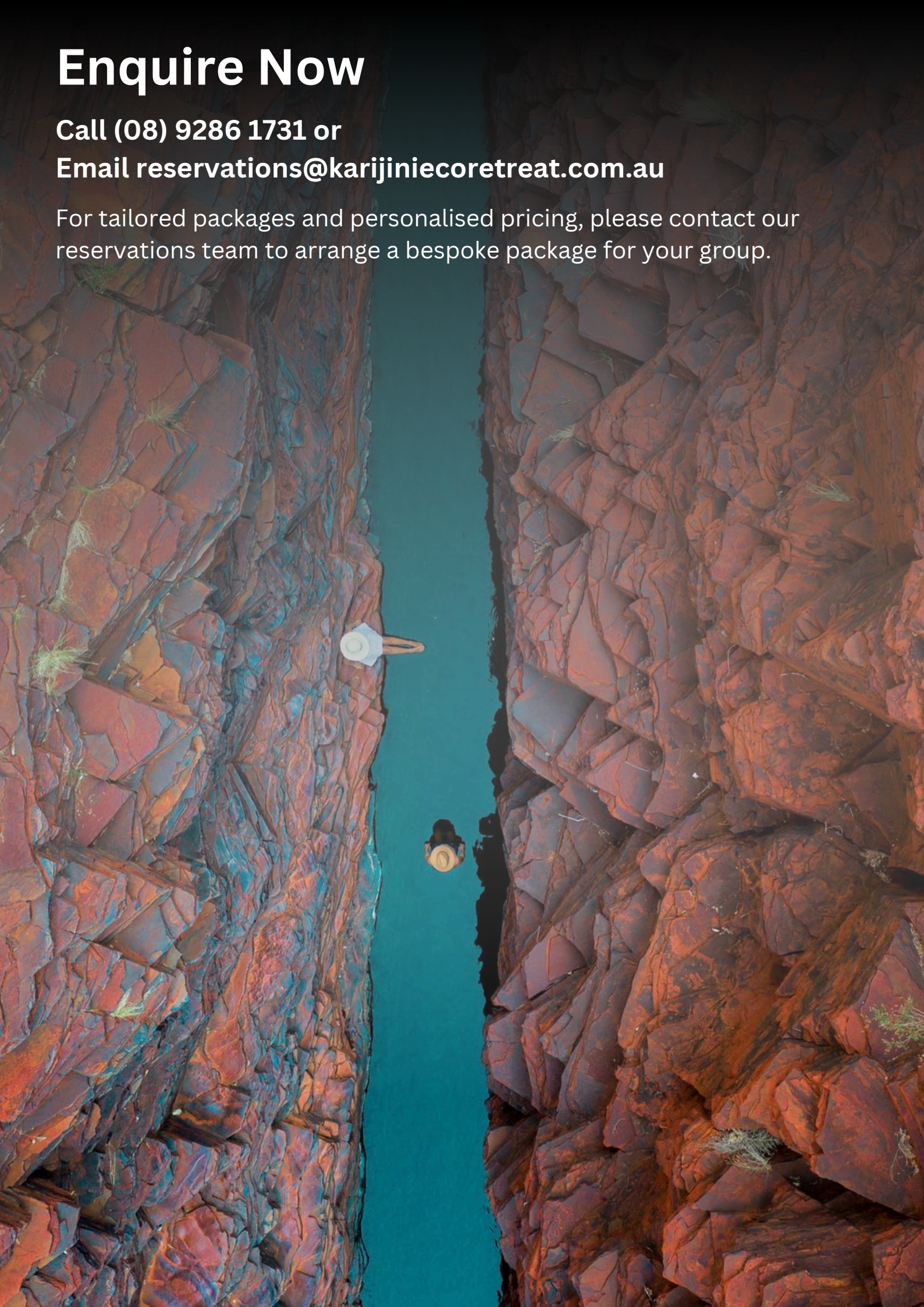

# Meeting & Event Terms + Conditions

Please read the terms and conditions below. In confirming your function by paying your deposit with the Karijini Eco Retreat, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions which constitute the agreement between the Karijini Eco Retreat and you (the parties). These terms and conditions apply to the exclusion of any other terms or conditions unless they are otherwise agreed to in writing by the parties. Previous dealings between the parties will not vary these terms and conditions. No purported variation of these terms and conditions will be effective unless in writing and signed by a person so authorised by the Karijini Eco Retreat.

**BOOKINGS:** Tentative function bookings will be held for 28 days. A deposit of 25% of the estimated total function cost is required to confirm your booking. A quotation does not automatically confirm a booking has been made.

**CONFIRMATION:** The booking is confirmed when we receive the deposit. If the deposit is not received within 28 days from when the tentative booking is made, the Karijini Eco Retreat have the right to cancel your booking.

**FINAL NUMBERS:** Final numbers must be confirmed 14 days prior to your function date. You will be required to pay the total function costs according to the final confirmed numbers. If numbers increase on the night, you will be required to pay the subsequent extra costs, however if the numbers decrease on the night, you will be required to pay as per the final confirmed numbers.

**PAYMENT:** A 25% deposit is required at the time of booking. Full payment is required 28 days prior to your event date. All events must have a credit card authorisation on file at the time of booking. On the day of the event, any outstanding balance will be charged to the credit card provided. Additionally, the credit card authorisation will be used as a security to cover any incidental expenses, damage costs to the venue, or specialist cleaning fees incurred as a result of your function.

**MENU, BEVERAGES AND DETAILS:** \*If applicable\* Menu choices are required 21 days prior to your event date. We are happy to cater for guests with allergies or special dietary requirements where possible, please confirm any special requests at the same time as your final menu choice. Karijini Eco Retreat's Outback Restaurant is a fully licensed venue; alcohol not purchased through the Restaurant cannot be brought onto or consumed inside the venue. The Outback Restaurant is committed to the Responsible Service of Alcohol and adheres to the Liquor Control Act 1988 (WA) at all times.

**PARKING:** On-site parking is free for ONE vehicle per eco tent only. Group and coach parking is free, subject to availability, and must be arranged in advance.
